As published in the Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette on May 14, 2021, article 31.48 has been modified.

Article 31.48 - Passing on of costs, as published November 01, 2018 ***previously*** read:

“A brand owner shall not charge a retailer and a retailer shall not charge a consumer a separate fee with respect to the costs associated with implementing or operating an oil and glycol stewardship plan or carrying out the brand owner’s duties under this Part.”

**Article 31.48 now reads:**

“A retailer shall not charge a consumer a separate fee with respect to the costs associated with implementing or operating an oil and glycol stewardship plan or carrying out the brand owner’s duties under this Part.”
