Please be advised of the following three new UOMA Atlantic initiatives.

**1. Increased Return Incentives on Used Glycol for Zone 5**

Based on market findings the UOMA Atlantic Board has approved an increase of \$0.26/litre to the Return Incentive (RI) for used glycol for Zone 5 in Newfoundland and Labrador. **This new RI will come into effect on January 01, 2021.**

**2. Temporary Increases in Return Incentives for Zones 2 and 3**

The UOMA Atlantic Board has approved a Temporary RI to collectors in Zones 2 and 3 in Newfoundland and Labrador. **These new RIs will come into effect on January 01, 2021.**

**IMPORTANT:** To collectors who submit their Return Incentive claims in paper format, please note: you will find on the UOMA-NL website a claim form for 2020 collections and one for 2021 collections. It is important to use the form corresponding to the year of your collections when making your claims.

### 3. **New Temporary Incentive for Drums and Bins**

The UOMA Atlantic Board has approved a temporary incentive to collectors for drums and bins installed at new generators in all five Zones in Newfoundland and Labrador. This new initiative is retroactive to October 1, 2020.

The incentive will consist of a reimbursement of **\$50 per new drum or bin to new generators** that will become part of the UOMA-NL collection facility network.

In order for this incentive to be paid, the collector will have to fulfill the following conditions.

**Collectors must provide UOMA-Atlantic with:**

- The generator business name, civic address, contact name and phone number of the new generator recruited;
- the number of drums and bins setup at each new location;
- the proof of delivery of such drums and bins at each new location;
- details of the collection agreement between the collector and each new facility (i.e. pick-up frequency with approximate pick-up dates).

Note that these three new initiatives will be posted on our UOMA-NL website.
